SUBJECT: SAVE-A-HOME LOAN PROGRAM – MAXIMUM DSELP LOAN REDUCED TO

\$5,000

The purpose of this Directive is to inform you that <u>effective close of business on Friday</u>, <u>August 30, 2013</u>, the maximum DSELP loan amount will be reduced from \$6,500 to \$5,000 for the Save-A-Home Loan Program. Per the Maryland Mortgage Program (MMP) and US Bank guidelines, these funds can be leveraged with other approved (allowable) closing cost assistance programs.
